IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MONTAGUE COUNTY, TEXAS

ORDER EXEMPTING PURCHASE OF AN ITEM SUBJECT TO EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCEDURES

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 13th day of April, 2015, the Commissioners Court of Montague County, Texas, after due notice, took up for consideration and possible action the exercise of discretion authorized by §262.024 of the Texas Local Government Code, subsection (a) (1)(5), to exempt from competitive bidding procedures the purchase of individual work performed and paid for by the day, as the work progresses, provided that no individual is compensated under this exemption for more than 20 working days in any three month period.

IT IS the finding of the Commissioners Court that the public interest will be served by the County purchase of such individual work or services, specifically in regard to the hauling of road building materials by the day, due to the unpredictable and periodic need for additional hauling capacity, and the inability to accurately or efficiently bid for such services. It is the further finding that competitive bidding procedures are not likely to produce the best value nor are such procedures appropriate for the specific needs of the County in regard to specific or optimally located road materials, the availability of hauling capacity beyond that possessed by the County, and the ability to obtain such services during times of high demand for such services at reasonable prices by way of competitive bidding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Montague County Commissioners Court has determined to grant the statutory exemption for the purchase such individual work by the day, as provided by §262.024 of the Texas Local Government Code.
