DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF MONTAGUE on the 9<sup>th</sup> DAY of JUNE 2015, has suffered widespread or severe damage, or loss of crops, livestock, grasslands or property or there is imminent threat of the same, resulting from torrential rainfall and severe weather conditions, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Montague County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MONTAGUE COUNTY, that a local state of disaster of agriculture is hereby declared for Montague County pursuant to §418.108(b) of the *Texas Government Code*.


Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the COMMISSIONERS COURT of MONTAGUE COUNTY


Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the MONTAGUE COUNTY CLERK.

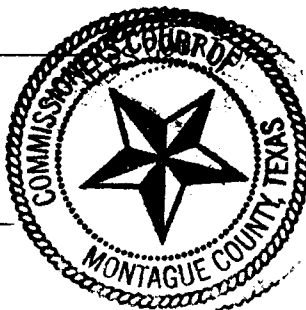
Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Montague County emergency management plan.


That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.


