A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MONTAGUE COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND REVITALIZATION BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM(GLO-CDR) APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE FOR THE (2015 FLOOD DISASTER GRANT); AND AUTHORIZING (THE COUNTY JUDGE) TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND REVITALIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Montague County desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low- to moderate-income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Montague County to apply for funding under the Texas General Land Office Community Development and Revitalization Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MONTAGUE COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That a Texas General Land Office Community Development and Revitalization Program application for the (2015 Flood Disaster Grant) is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas General Land Office.
- 2. That the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the (2015 Flood Disaster Grant).
- 3. That the application be for (\$999,999.00) of grant funds to provide (roads, bridges and bridge approaches).
- 4. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates (the County Judge) as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas General Land Office Community Development and Revitalization Program.
- 5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, and civil rights requirements.
