The administration advised jailer Womack was on vacation when the quarterly meeting was conducted and she went through training at a later date but didn't document the training. The administration was advised to ensure all jail staff are trained in life safety quarterly as required be minimum jail standards and the training is documented. <u>Follow up required – The administration was scan and email a copy of the 4th quarter training when all staff have been trained.</u>

If the supervisor notification is not noted a required, a letter of noncompliance will be issued. 2). During the review of the mental disabilities suicide prevention plan this inspector recommended the administration amend the current plan. The plan states those inmates who are potentially suicidal will be checked every 15 minutes. This inspector advised per minimum jail standards the required face to face observation on inmates who are potentially suicidal be done at a minimum of 30 minutes. <u>No follow up required.</u></u>
