Significant Investigations/Calls:

- Deputies arrested a total of 29 people on 29 on-view charges and 22 warrants.
- 1 search warrant executed resulting in one arrest for possession of suspected methamphetamine.
- There was a reported stabbing in the City of Bowie, Deputies responded to assist. A Deputy administered first-aid to the victim using QuikClot to stop the bleeding.
- Deputies stopped two vehicles travelling together, resulting in the arrest of 6 persons, and found to be in the possession of suspected marihuana, ecstasy, methamphetamine, crack/cocaine, and various prescription pills.
