Significant Investigations/Calls:

- 22 people arrested on 9 On-View Charges and 25 Warrants
- On 08-04-2019 Deputies made a traffic stop in Sunset. Deputies located a card skimming device in the vehicle. 2 suspects were arrested. Sheriff Thomas conducted a security check at a nearby gas station and found one of the gas pumps to be tampered with. Ongoing investigation.

- On 08-15-2019 received a report of a female being held against her will and assaulted. The suspect, a known felon, was also to be in possession of a firearm. The victim was located, Deputies executed a search warrant at the residence, resulting in the recovery of a firearm, a large amount of suspected methamphetamine, and evidence related to the reported assault. 1 of 2 suspects were apprehended at the time and charged with Unlawful Restraint and Aggravated Assault.
- On 08-23-2019 Deputies assisted in a Federal Warrant Round-up.
- On 08-23-2019 Deputies arrived at a residence to serve 4 felony arrest warrants. The suspect was seen with a firearm and fired upon Deputies. Sgt. Brandle, a Crisis/Hostage Negotiator, negotiated with the suspect for approximately 2 hours, resulting in the suspect surrendering.
