New Programs and/or Equipment:

- Jail Captain, Carolyn Berryman, retired on December 31st after nine (9) years of service, resulting in the promotion of Jail Sergeant, Jean Meyer's, to Jail Captain and Detention Officer, Tyler Prastik, to Jail Sergeant.

Significant Investigations/Calls:

- Deputies arrested 42 people on 28 on-view charges and 47 warrants.
- Deputies responded to a report of Criminal Trespass in progress. Before arriving Deputies learned the vehicle used by the suspect was stolen. Deputies arrived on scene, but the suspect was already gone. Deputies located the stolen vehicle at another residence. Deputies had information the suspect was inside. Deputy Pelton

and K-9 Ace arrived on scene. Deputy Pelton made announcements before sending K-9 Ace in the residence. Suspect surrendered to Deputies during the K-9 announcements.

- Deputies received information and obtained a search warrant for a residence for an individual with felony warrants. During execution of the search warrant, Deputies located drug paraphernalia inside the residence. Deputies obtained another search warrant for narcotics. Deputies recovered methamphetamine and dangerous drug (prescription pills) inside the residence. After further investigation, warrants were obtained on multiple individuals for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance and tampering with evidence.
