We received 4 responses to the RFP that did not follow the procedure outlined in the RFP, so they should be considered invalid at this time.

We received 1 response that followed the RFP process as requested. The total amount bid on that RFP was \$239,100.00. The grant application we submitted was approved for \$115,855.00. We could request a modification to the grant for the increased amount, but the request is not guaranteed – especially considering the size of the increase we would have to apply for.

I recommend that this bid be rejected, and that we regroup and reconsider our options to move forward on this project.
