PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in January of 1984, a presidential proclamation was issued by President Ronald Reagan designating that month to hereafter be known as National Sanctity of Human Life Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, in this same presidential proclamation, the third Sunday of the month of January is to be observed as National Sanctity of Human Life Day; and

WHEREAS, the latest United States statistics alone cite 63.6 million abortions performed from 1973 to 2020; and

WHEREAS, a closer look at that number breaks down to 930,160 abortions in the US in 2020, with the number further broken down to 2,548 a day; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this month is to bring a greater awareness to these atrocious figures, and the attacks that are daily waged against human life through the abortion industry in a never-ending cycle; and

WHEREAS, one of the best ways we can protect unborn lives is by bringing into the light the darkness of abortion, and making known the supportive resources available in our county; and

WHEREAS, greater efforts of supporting our local pregnancy resource organization who daily reach women and families with messages of "Help for today and Hope for tomorrow"; and

WHEREAS, it seems good and right to bring these facts to light and encourage all of Montague County to honor those unborn who have already been taken from us as we stand up for the unborn of the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the County Commissioners of Montague County, do hereby proclaim the month of January 2026 and Sunday, January 18, 2026 as
